OGS TO HOLD PUBLIC AUCTION FOR STRUCTURE IN THE TOWN OF SENNETT

New York State Office of General Services (OGS) Commissioner John C. Egan today announced that OGS will hold a public auction on Wednesday, August 26, of a property in the Cayuga County Town of Sennett that was formerly used as a residential center by the Office of Children and Family Services. The auction will be held at the Sennett Town Hall, at 6931 Cherry Street Road, Auburn. Registration begins at 12:30 p.m.

Description of Property For Sale:

The property being auctioned is a single-story institutional building with approximately 12,780 square feet of living area. There are three wings in the main building, an educational section with classrooms, a dormitory and a living area. There are four out-buildings on the property. The lot size is approximately 10 acres. The minimum bid is \$175,000.

The above property is being sold "as is." Prospective bidders are urged to obtain professional advice prior to the auction to assure compliance with building codes and any planned use of the property.
