FALL SURPLUS VEHICLE AUCTIONS SCHEDULED STATEWIDE
New York State Surplus Sales and Auctions Raise \$5.5 Million in Fiscal Year 2009-10

New York State Office of General Services (OGS) Commissioner, John C. Egan, today announced that sales of state surplus generated \$5.5 million in Fiscal Year (FY) 2009 – 10. Nearly 1,400 eBay sales of items including farm equipment, computers and communications devices netted the state \$1.3 million. The live auction of 3,500 surplus vehicles and equipment netted \$4.2 million. Monies generated from the sales of surplus goods are added to the state's general fund.

“Sales of surplus equipment and vehicles allow the state to recoup monies for items that have served their purpose for the government and then puts those items back into use in the private sector. In addition to good stewardship of taxpayer dollars, this is also an important part of the OGS commitment to sustainability,” Commissioner Egan said. “Governor Paterson has made saving money a clear priority in his administration and surplus sales meet that mandate.”
