OGS TO AUCTION SEIZED PORSCHE AT APRIL 20 VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT AUCTION IN ALBANY

The New York State Office of General Services has added a 2012 Porsche Cayenne SUV to the list of items the public can bid on at a surplus vehicle, highway equipment, and miscellaneous property auction scheduled to start at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday, April 20 at the Harriman State Office Building Campus in Albany. Items being sold will be available for inspection starting at 8:30 a.m. on the day of the auction.

The Porsche, with approximately 14,850 miles on its odometer, was seized by the Attorney General's Office in 2013 following an investigation into a \$3.2 million Medicaid fraud case in Brooklyn. Proceeds from the sale of the car will be transferred to the Attorney General's Medicaid Fraud Unit.
