If approved, the updated (new) price list and contract changes shall become effective upon the issuance of a contract amendment by our office.

Upon request, contractor shall furnish without charge, copies of price lists identical to those accepted with bids (and accepted future updated price lists) and catalogs or brochures, to all state agencies, political subdivisions, and others authorized by law to purchase from this resulting contract.

**OVERLAPPING CONTRACT ITEMS:**

Products available in this contract may also be available from other State contracts. Agencies will be advised to select the most cost effective procurement alternative that meets their program requirements and to maintain a procurement record documenting the basis for this selection.

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**PREFERRED SOURCE PRODUCTS:**
