**FOUR COMPANIES RECEIVE NEW YORK STATE
SERVICE-DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS CERTIFICATION**

Office of General Services Commissioner today announced that the following five businesses have recently been certified by the Office of General Services' (OGS) Division of Service-Disabled Veterans' Business Development (DSDVBD):

- Candence Mirco Electronics, LLC, located in Massapequa Park, NY, is an electronic distributor.
- First Environment, Inc., located in New York, NY, which provides environmental consulting.
- Helios Environmental, LLC, located in Orchard Park, NY, which provides environmental consulting, planning and permitting, biological assessments, and ecological restoration.
- James Edward Meigs d/b/a Able Contracting d/b/a JEM Trucking, located in Elka Park, NY, which provides trucking and consulting services.

The Division was created by Governor Andrew Cuomo in May, 2014 with enactment of the Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Act. As of April 17, 2017, a total of 321 businesses have been certified.

The Act promotes and encourages participation of SDVOBs in NYS public procurements of public works, commodities, services and technology to foster and advance economic development in the State. More information on the program and the certification process can be found here
