FOUR COMPANIES RECEIVE New York STATE SERVICE-DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS CERTIFICATION

Office of General Services Commissioner today announced that the following four businesses have recently been certified by the Office of General Services' (OGS) Division of Service-Disabled Veterans' Business Development (DSDVBD):

- Mobile Nations, Inc., located in Forest Hills, NY, is a packing and office supply distributor.
- Shona Mechanical, Inc., located in Setauket, NY, specializes in HVAC services.
- Millbrook Support Services, Inc., located in Millbrook, NY, provides staffing and outsources services.
- Chicho & Son Corporation d/b/a Controlled Security Systems, located in Whitestone, NY, installs telecommunication devices.

The Division was created by Governor Andrew Cuomo in May, 2014 with enactment of the Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Act. As of May 2, 2017, a total of 325 businesses have been certified.

The Act promotes and encourages participation of SDVOBs in NYS public procurements of public works, commodities, services and technology to foster and advance economic development in the State. More information on the program and the certification process can be found here
