

Whether in the office or out in the field, oftentimes smaller purchases need to be made. These can range from office supplies to batteries to cleaning products to flyers/posters, and in most instances, there are options for these that are more sustainable than others. As part of the Executive Order 4 green purchasing program, the GreenNY Council has put together green specifications that agencies are required to follow to ensure that products the State is buying have a lower environmental impact.

When making a purchase with your procurement card, first check the **GreenNY website list of approved specifications** to see if there is a specification for the type of product you are buying. Some common items that there are specifications for include (but are not limited to):

- AA, AAA, and D Batteries
- Printing Services
- > State-funded Hotel Rooms
- Floor Finishes and Floor Removers
- General Purpose Cleaners
- Hand Cleaners, Hand Soaps, and Consumer Antiseptics
- **№** Ink
- Monochrome Toner Cartridges

- Janitorial Paper Products
- > Trash Bags
- **Paint**
- Mulch
- > Disinfectants and Sanitizers
- Reusable Bags
- Pest Management for Indoor and Outdoor Spaces
- **Lubricants**
