# What is the 1122 Program?



# Provides Participating State and Local Governments Access to Federal Sources of Supply



What makes the program unique...it gives state and local governments access to federal stock items (equipment and supplies).



# Supports Three Specific Missions

1. Counter Drug
2. Emergency Response Activities
3. Homeland Security Efforts



# Counter Drug

## Requirements

- Enforces anti-drug laws
- Engages in or supports prevention, intervention or suppression activities related to counter illegal drug activity in our communities

# Emergency Response

## Requirements

- Provides immediate support services during prevention, response, and recovery operations related to emergency management



# Homeland Security

## Requirements

- Prevents and protects New York from terrorist attacks
- Reduces America's vulnerability to terrorism, major disasters, and other emergencies
- Minimizes the damage and helps recover from attacks, major disasters, and other emergencies



# Who Can Use the Program?

December 2015

New York launched the 1122 Program for local governments.

March 2018

New York expanded the 1122 Program to include New York State agencies.

# When Can I Buy Items?

The 1122 Program may be utilized any time a Public Safety Agency needs to support one of the three specific mission types to:

- Prepare
- Respond
- Recover



# What can you buy through the 1122 Program?

- Aviation Parts including aviation fuel
- Laboratory Equipment
- Vehicle Parts
- Mobile Command Centers
- Rescue Equipment
- Highway Maintenance Equipment

# Federal Sources Of Supply (SOS)

## Sources of Supply (SOS) fall into two categories:

1. **Federal stock items** -- direct buys
  - Department of the Army
  - Defense Logistics Agency
2. **Third party vendor** -- direct buys
  - General Services Administration (GSA) schedules



# General Services Administration

## Examples of 1122 Approved Schedules (Contracts)

**Schedule 23V:** Vehicular Multiple Award Schedule (**Command Centers only**)

**Schedule 58:** Professional Audio/Video

**Schedule 66:** Scientific Equipment

**Schedule 67:** Photographic Equipment-Cameras, Photographic Printers and Related Supplies (Digital and Film-Based)


**Schedule 70:** General Purpose Commercial Information, Technology Equipment, Software

**Schedule 84:** Total Solutions for law Enforcement, Security, Facility Management Systems, Fire, Rescue, Special Purpose Clothing, Marine Craft, and Emergency/Disaster Response



# GSA Schedules authorized for use by State and Local Governments categorized by program.

- GSA offers 3 Programs to State and Local Governments each with unique requirements for participation
- DLA & Army Stock Items are **exclusively** available through the 1122 Program
- 13 Schedules are authorized for use under the 1122 Program providing an exhaustive list of equipment contracts

# You must complete two separate steps prior to placing an order with a vendor

**1.** Get certified as a Public Safety Agency (PSA)

**2.** Request authorization to place an order.

# How To Get Certified



# How to Get Certified

Only certified Public Safety Agencies (PSA) may make purchases through the 1122 Program.

## Getting certified is easy

1. Use one Certification Letter template for each category requested. The templates can be found on our website [www.nyspro.ogs.ny.gov](http://www.nyspro.ogs.ny.gov) as a guide.
2. Submit your Certification request letter(s) and please ensure that you have provided all the requested information as outlined in the template.
3. Upon receipt, your letter will be reviewed and if approved, a certification approval letter will be sent to the requesting entity welcoming them into the 1122 Program.

# Get Certified (continued) Before You Purchase...

- Please ensure that the Requesting Officer and Public Safety Representative have signing authority and have secured authorization to purchase in accordance with your guidelines;
- Note in your Procurement Record your demonstrated need for the purchase.



# Standard Purchasing Procedures

Purchasing procedures differ between units of local government and state agencies.

## General Municipal Law

General Municipal Law, section 104(2) authorizes the use of certain federal contracts by local governments to make purchases pursuant to Section 1122 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal year 1994.

Use of these contracts constitutes an exception to the competitive bidding and offering requirements of the law.



# Standard Purchasing Procedures

## State Finance Law

New York State Finance Law does not contain similar exemption language, which requires state agencies to complete a few additional steps depending on the purchase amount.


- If purchase is greater than \$50K, the 1122 Quote Request Form must be used.
