1	RFP Main Document	Section 2.1 Qualifications	Number 2 page 11 requires at least \$250,000 in sales to a government agency for the previous 3 years, which we have, however we do not have it under LOT 11 titles. We do have experience outside of government contracts with LOT 11 job titles. Would that disqualify us from bidding?	Yes, this is a requirement. Per Solicitation Section 2.1 Qualifications, At least \$250,000, per year, in prior sales made to governmental entities, for the three (3) years immediately preceding the Bid opening date, and which sales were made for comparable services or titles to the Lots for which they are bidding on this Solicitation.
2	RFP Main Document	Section 2.1 Qualifications	Number 4 page 11 requires 3 references of governmental accounts similar in in size and scope. We do work with several government entities, but only one would be in a contract capacity similar in size. Would this disqualify us from bidding?	No. Per Section 2.1 Quailifications, this is only if requested after bid review.
3	Attachment 1: Pricing		Do you have to bid on all job titles within the region?	No. Bidders may bid on all or some Titles, and/or Regions. Contractors will only be eligible to respond to RFQs for any Titles/Lots and/or Regions that they have been awarded.
4	RFP Main Document	Section 1.1 Overview	Can current Contractors bid on lots/titles already awarded?	No. Per Section 1.1 Overview, Current Contractors may not resubmit a Bid for consideration under this Periodic Recruitment relating to any titles in a Lot or Region previously awarded to that Contractor. A Contractor may; however, Bid on titles and/or Regions within Lot 11 not previously awarded to the Contractor.
