



Four Methods of Procurement

Understanding New York State's Buying Process

Procurement involves the purchasing of goods (commodities) and services. If you are a government organization in New York State, the buying process can be understood through the following steps:

- Step 1:** Identify your need and timeline.
- Step 2:** Determine your buying process & follow it.
- Step 3:** Select a vendor & make an award.
- Step 4:** Receive the goods, services, or commodities.
- Step 5:** Receive & pay the invoice.

The buying process is different for each type of organization in New York State, and you should understand which rules and regulations apply to you.

State agencies must procure commodities or services in the following order according to the Finance Law:

1. From a **Preferred Source** vendor.
2. Through an OGS Procurement Services **centralized contract**.
3. **Piggybacking on existing contracts**. This means that you can receive the same services and commodities as the contract holders at the same price.
4. **Conducting your own procurement**, including discretionary purchases. This form of competitive bidding requires you to follow your own rules and regulations. Contracts are awarded on a basis of best value and lowest bidder.

Pay the invoice after the procurement is complete. For State agencies that are customers of the OGS Business Services Center, invoices should be reviewed and approved by the agency and then emailed to Accounts Payable at AccountsPayable@ogs.ny.gov.

Buying 101 – Municipalities

Municipalities & Local Governments

Local governments do not follow the same government procurement laws as state agencies. Instead, their purchasing process is shaped by General Municipal Law and whatever policies and procedures that the local government adopts. There are several types of procurement for local entities to consider:

- **Piggybacking on existing contracts.** This means that you can receive the same services and commodities as the contract holders at the same price.
- **Conducting your own procurement.** This form of competitive bidding requires you to follow not only your own rules and regulations but that of General Municipal Law. Contracts are awarded on a basis of best value and lowest bidder. To learn more check out the [OSC Local Government Management Guide: Seeking Competition in Procurement \(PDF\)](#).
- **Cooperative purchasing.** This is when two or more local entities seek to purchase goods or services together, resulting in greater purchasing power and cost savings. Any city, town, village, county, fire or school district, BOCES, and improvement districts can sign an intergovernmental cooperative agreement to seek procurement together.

ELIGIBILITY

Become an Authorized User

If you are, among others, a state agency, a public authority or benefit corporation, a local government or political subdivision, a volunteer organization (such as ambulance services & fire companies), or a registered charitable organization, you may be eligible to use OGS centralized statewide contracts. Contracts are divided into three types:

- Commodity (e.g., fuel, vehicles, office supplies, and food)
- Service (e.g., elevator maintenance)
- Technology (e.g., hardware, software, telecommunications, and IT services)

For local governments and other government organizations, including schools and public authorities, no additional paperwork beyond your purchase order is needed. If you don't have an authorized user identification number, we ask that you complete a simple eligibility application. This will provide assurances to companies that you are eligible to use state contracts.





Preferred Sources

If you are a state agency, a public benefit corporation (including most public authorities), a municipality, or a school district you are required by law to purchase commodities and services from Preferred Sources first if a Preferred Source offering meets your needs for **form, function, and utility**.

The advantage of this type of procurement is that you do not need to follow the competitive bid process.

While it is not possible for any private business to become a Preferred Source, it is possible for a business to partner with a Preferred Source. To identify these opportunities, contact the Preferred Source directly for information.

Cutting Costs
