



Overview

This guide will define the various sales order statuses found on reports run on the Web Based Supply Chain Management (WBSCM) website.

For example, these statuses would appear in the Sales Order Status column of the Requisition Status Report.

Acronyms

FNS = USDA Food & Nutrition Service

SDA = State Distributing Agency (OGS Food Distribution)

AMS = USDA Agricultural Market Service
(Bids for Fruits & Vegetables, Livestock, & Poultry)

FSA = USDA Farm Service Agency
(Bids for Dairy, Grains, Oil, & Peanut Butter)

Co-op = Recognized school Co-op

Sales Order Status Definitions

Status	Meaning
Applied	Orders related to redistribution/re-donation
Cancelled	Order has been cancelled
Ready for Approval	Order has been created and is ready for approval
Returned by Co-op	Order has been returned for changes by a Co-op
Approved by Co-op	Order has been approved by a Co-op
Returned by SDA	Order has been returned for changes by SDA
Approved by SDA	Order has been approved by SDA
Returned by SpAgency	Order has been returned for changes by FNS
Approved by SpAgency	Order has been approved by FNS
Returned by FSA/AMS	Order has been returned by FSA/AMS
On Invitation	Order has been sent out for USDA approved vendors to bid on
Purchased	Order has been purchased
Order Received	Order has been received by an area distributor
Resubmit to FSA/AMS	Order has been resubmitted to FSA/AMS
